Seven out of 10 (72 per cent) Australians take out travel insurance before heading off on an overseas holiday.

More than one-quarter of Australians (28 per cent) are taking a risk by not buying travel insurance when going on holiday, with a quarter of those (26 per cent) saying it is an added cost they can't afford.

Almost half of all travellers (46 per cent) said they purchased insurance through their travel agent, which resulted in higher fees.

WHAT DOES AAMI'S INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE COVER?

AAMI International Travel Insurance is for permanent Australian residents aged between 18 and 65 and their dependents aged under 18.
